2nd Workshop on Innovative, Interactive and Digital Teaching

Following the 1st Week of international Teaching (WIT) in Brno, on March 2022, the 2nd Workshop on Innovative Interactive and Digital teaching was successfully held in Luxembourg. The event was held at Hotel Parc Belle-Vue from September 16th to September 19th, 2022. This on-site international event was organized by Novel Group and constituted an intensive program for teaching staff, where 21 participants from the Higher Education Institutions (HEIs) of partner countries were able to attend on-site. Moreover, being a hybrid event in nature, it gave the opportunity to anyone unable to attend, to follow the presentations online, and to participate in the relevant discussions.

What were the Topics included in the agenda?

The program was rich and consisted of the following topics:

Digital Skills and Digital Transformation in Education: The purpose of this presentation was to outline the definition and main aspects of digital education, to present the latest trends/advances and key technologies in the area, and to discuss the essential digital literacy skills which will assist the future employability of students.

Digital Learning and Innovative Tools: The thematic focus of this presentation revolved around ways to promote digital literacy in the classroom as well as the concept and basic tools of Educational Technology. The final part of this presentation demonstrated a variety of useful digital education tools.

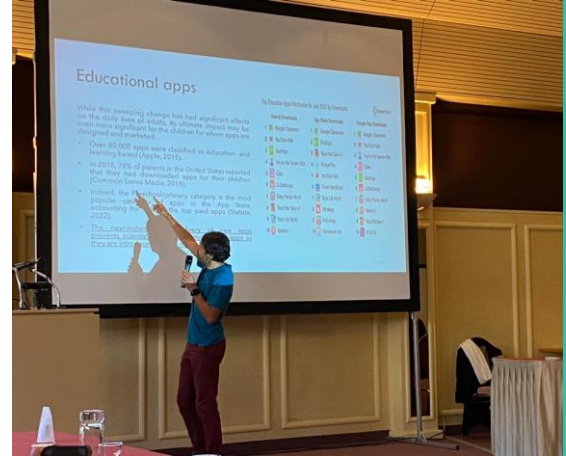


Inclusive and Interactive Teaching Strategies: This presentation debated the importance of the implementation of inclusive and interactive education, followed by Innovative Teaching methods and strategies to promote Inclusive and interactive learning.

Playful Teaching for Higher Education: This presentation addressed general presentation skills, including presentation design, styles, frequent mistakes to avoid and course content development

Digital Educational Platform - The example of EBP e-Toolkit: The theme of this presentation was the projection of an open and creative e-toolkit supporting the European Nursing Curriculum on Evidence Based Practice (EBP). The EBP e-Toolkit project is a Strategic Partnership of six European Higher Education Institutions.

Educational Apps for Young Age Students: The main topics discussed in this presentation were the effects of touchscreen technology on young children's learning, educational apps, and the difference between computational thinking and computational fluency with relevant apps.



Transforming and Adapting IUC Courses to Interactive Online Practices of Teaching and Learning. "A Story of Muddling Through":

This presentation was based upon the real-life experience of the Inter-University Centre Dubrovnik, on their effort to tackle the devastating effects of the pandemic, transfer to online and hybrid models of education and develop a contingency plan to prevent total disruption of the pedagogical process in the future.

The agenda was enriched by thematic Sessions and cooperative learning activities (Think Pare Share) and the overall experience was rounded off with field trip visits to the cities of Luxembourg and Trier. The occasion offered attendees an opportunity to discover more about their colleagues, build up on their networking and exchange knowledge and best practices with other professionals.

Presentation of WITEA-ID at the 4th Panhellenic Conference of Young Researchers

The WITEA-ID was also presented at the 4th Panhellenic Conference of Young Researchers in Teaching Science and New Technologies in Education from September 16th to September 18th, 2022. Members from the University of Crete (UOC) emphasizing the need for innovation in international mobility and inclusive education.
